The Worker Exchange System

Owners, contractors, unions and workers are now able to mutually share worker compliance information with other organizations; while still owning and administering your organizations data!

Unlike a centralized solution, worker data is stored by the organization.

Participating organizations can easily verify that workers from outside jurisdictions are compliant with local work-site safety rules such as drug testing, safety training and orientations.

Like an ATM network, the WES allows for sharing of essential read-only worker information with other participating organizations via the WES Hub.



What is the Worker Exchange System (WES)?

A system that seamlessly exchanges unionized worker information amongst different jurisdictions. The WES was created with the goal of eliminating redundant costs and to establish a nationwide Union Network that will share worker data around the country, seamlessly and instantaneously.

Why the Worker Exchange System (WES)?

- * Save time and money by eliminating duplicate testing.
- * Participating organizations can easily verify work-site safety compliance.
- * Worker data is NOT stored by any party other than the local program.
